Our topics this term will be based around a variety of interesting and unusual fairy tales. We will share lots of stories, including The Snow Queen, The Little Red Hen and The Emperor's New Clothes. We will be writing invitations, letters, stories and information, alongside daily phonics sessions.

In science we shall learn about materials, exploring their uses and investigating which materials are best for a specific purpose. In our topic sessions we will find out about the weather, including wind, snow and the climate around the world. This will tie in with our art and DT lessons where we shall paint, use chinks, make models using clay and cook.

Our music lessons will focus on pulse, rhythm and orchestration, initially using Saint Saens 'Carnival of the animals'.

Our maths sessions will begin with counting, ordering and reading and writing numbers. We shall then move onto using numbers to solve problems, including addition and subtraction.

Paul Ward will take PE on a Tuesday afternoon. We will also have other PE lessons so please can PE kits be in school all the time.

Outdoor Learning will be on a Friday afternoon, so on a Friday children can come to school in old and warm clothes. Please make sure children have wellies in school on a Friday - we will provide waterproofs to keep everyone dry!

I have planned lots of exciting activities which I can't wait to teach! Please remember that Reception parents are very welcome to come into school in the morning to help hang up coats and to see their child begin their day. I will bring the children out after school every day so please do ask me if you have any questions.
