Following our trip to the Hippodrome in Great Yarmouth, our topic this term will be based around stories and activities related to circuses.

In literacy we will share a wide variety of books, including fiction and information. We will write stories, make books and role play characters. In our art sessions we shall make a big top, design and make shoe box circuses, paint performers and create moving pictures. We will learn lots of circus songs and listen to classical music related to the circus and then have a go at composing our own music. In science we will focus on Forces, using technical vocabulary such as squeeze and manipulate. Our history sessions will teach us about how the circus began and how they have changed. We shall also learn about the Chinese State circus. In maths we will follow the National objectives for the Foundation Stage, Year One and Year Two. Our R.E. this term will allow us to ask what Jews remember on Shabbat and what the cross means to Christians. We will also explore the Easter story towards the end of term. As it is very cold and windy on our field during the winter we will restart Outdoor Learning in the summer term.
